Introduction

Congratulations on upcoming wedding. I'm glad you're considering video.

I have a deep passion to support loving and lasting marriages. One of the ways I do that is by helping preserve your special day on video without breaking the bank. I offer a range of affordable packages.

I work with every couple personally and look forward to telling your story and preserving the memories so you can remember your big day for decades to come.

Consultation and Customization

I am here to serve. I love to meet the bride and groom, when possible, so I am ready to:

- tell your story,
- celebrate your relationship, and
- preserve your special day on video.

I love to learn your unique stories as individuals and as a couple—how you met and how you moved from strangers, to dating, to bride and groom.

We'll discuss your plans for the day including any unique elements of the ceremony and reception. I don't need to know every single detail but if you are planning any surprises for your guests, your Videographer and Photographer should be in on the surprise otherwise, we may not catch the action in time. It would also help to know if there will be any significant songs. Copyright laws are very strict, but sometimes I can get the rights to use certain songs.

We'll discuss the style and focus you would like—including any vision and expectations for the video. We'll also identify the key shots and people to be sure to capture (like friends and relatives who have traveled far, etc.).

Every wedding is unique. When possible, I try to attend the rehearsal, so I can be best prepared to capture the most important moments for you. I may have some questions, but I make every effort to be invisible. My goal is to capture events without disrupting in any way.

Typical Ceremony Shots

These are the typical shots I work hard to get. We will customize this list.



	Entire ceremony, from prior to bride's entrance to the couple's walk down the aisle at the end
	Special parts of ceremony—solo, unity candle, etc.
	Reaction shots of bride and groom's families
	Video during the photographer's formal posed shots. Possibly a reenactment of the ring ceremony
	Wedding party leaving church



Typical Reception Shots

These are the typical shots I work hard to get. We will customize this list.



	Wedding party entering reception
	First dance
	Groom's dance with his mom
	Bride's dance with her dad
	Best man's toast. (Other toasts, if applicable)
	Cake cutting
	Special dances, ceremonies, or traditions
	Greetings from guests. (If possible)



Base Wedding Video Package

- An HD video of entire ceremony (start to finish)
- Key elements from the first hour of the reception (Wedding Party entrance and first dance).
- Adding select clips uploaded from attendees' smart phones or cameras.

Video Format Options

Option	Description	Notes
Raw footage ONLY	<p>This is a cost saving option for those who have experience in video editing and have the time available to edit their own video.</p> <p><i>Note: this is not recommended for the weak or inexperienced. To put it in perspective, think of the difference between a couple of yards of fabric and your wedding gown.</i></p>	
Highlight video (1 - 4 minutes)	Key highlights of the ceremony in a concise format with musical background. This can be delivered online with links to send family and friends.	
Full feature video (30 - 40 minutes)	A more in-depth opportunity to tell your story and preserve the memories of the special day. This can be delivered online with links to send family and friends.	
Raw footage	<p>This is an add-on for those who wish to have the unedited raw video from the cameras. (Taxable in some states)</p> <p><i>Note: This can be a nice addition to the package. It will add to the overall package price because of the size of the files (typically 50-120 GB) but may be helpful if you might enjoy looking at the rest of the story and memories that did not make it on to the edited versions.</i></p>	\$150.00



Technical Specifications



Videographers and equipment

Videographers	1 (I work alone but bring at least two active video cameras and often additional source for backup or special shots.)
Video Camera – Main	1 – Sony FDR AX33 (4K Capable)
Video Cameras – Backup and Special Shots	1 – Sony HDR CX 240 (Full HD) 2 – Smart Phones Full HD Cameras (iPhone X, Samsung S9+) (Last resort backup and additional POV shots.)
Audio	1 Zoom H4N Recorder, Shotgun Mic on Main Camera 2 –Lavalier Microphones (AT, Rode SmartLav+)
Lighting	LED continuous video lighting available, if needed.

Delivery of Video Files

Internet Download	Download via Dropbox, Google Drive, etc. This is the fastest and least expensive option. Mass residents: This method may NOT require sales tax.
USB Flash Drive	This is a safe and easy delivery method. (These drives seem to be virtually indestructible.) Mass residents: This method may require sales tax.
External Hard Drive	This is an easy delivery method due to their portability and storage size. Mass residents: This method may require sales tax.
DVD	One Master DVD and Five Copies. Mass residents: This method may require sales tax.
